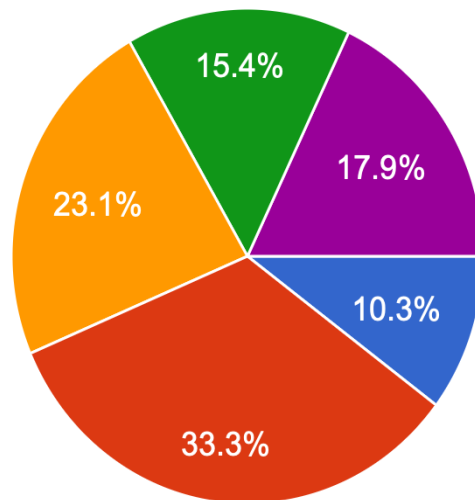
Member Survey

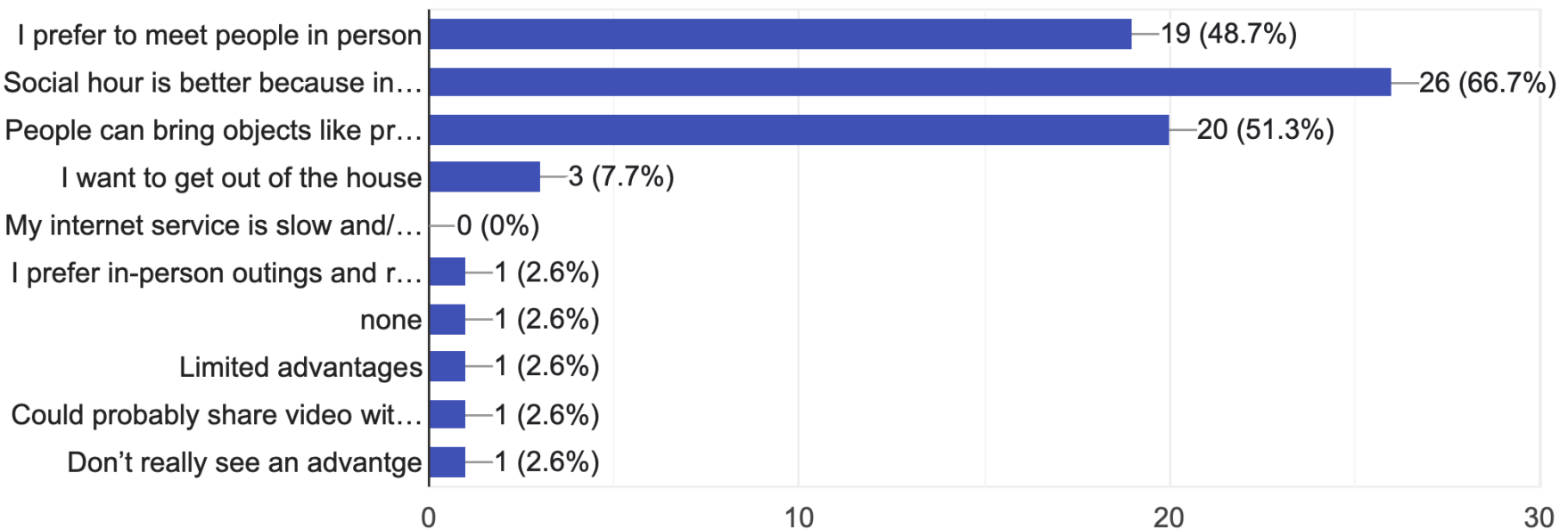


- I want all general meetings to be in person

What do you see as the advantages of in-person meetings?

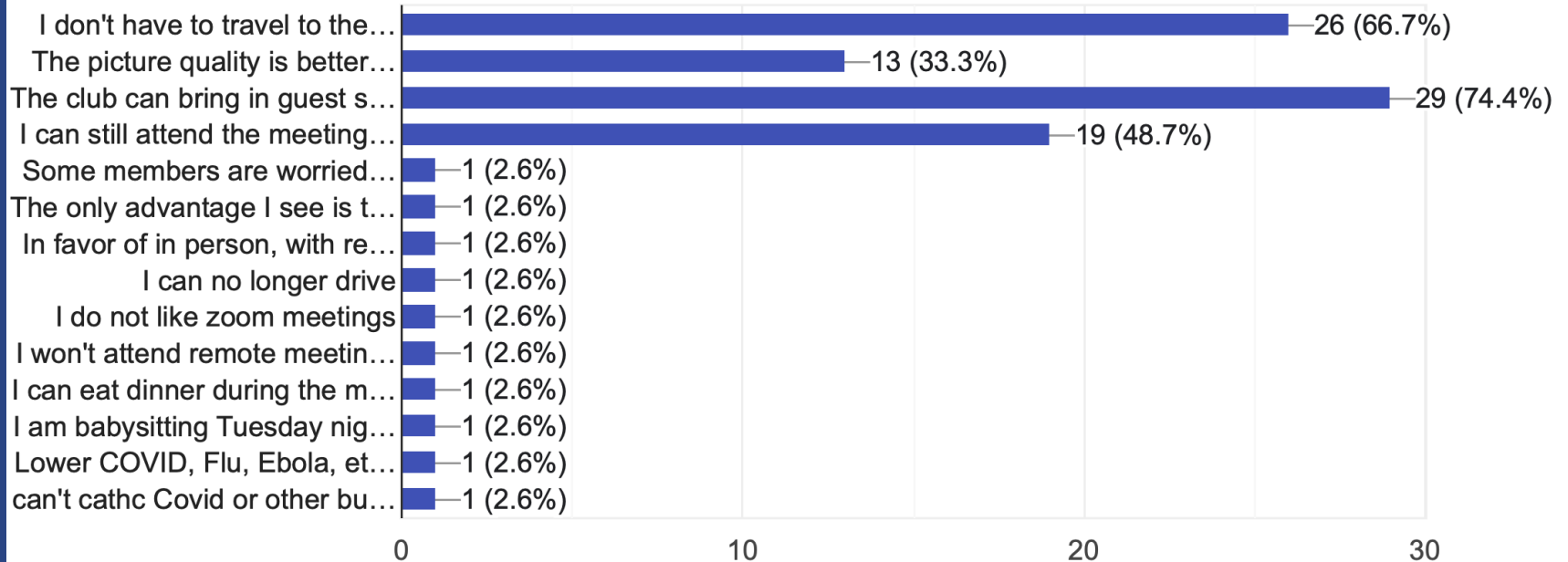

What do you see as the advantages of remote meetings?

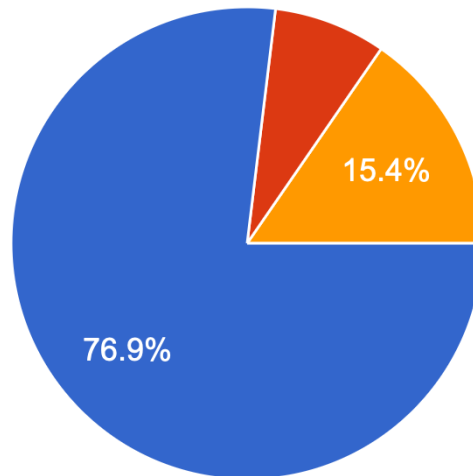

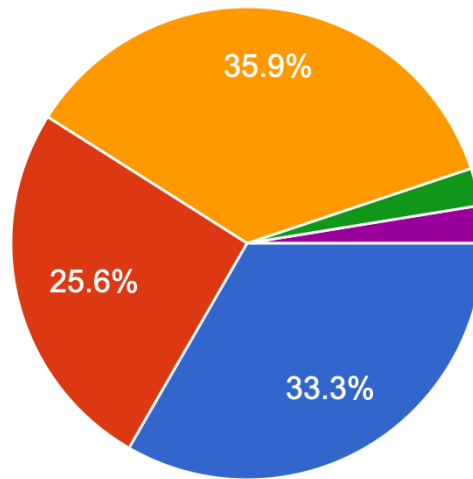


- This is a good idea [to try to retain the advantages of both methods]

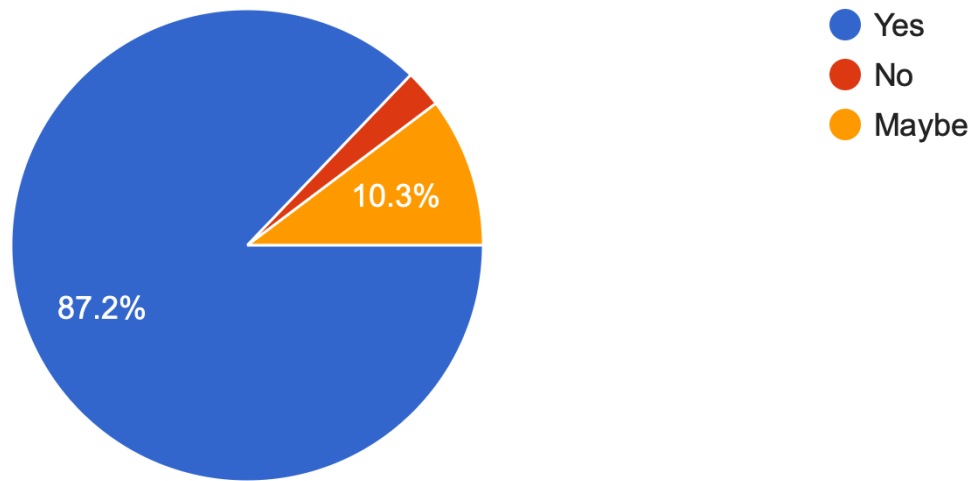


- I would most likely attend in person

If FCDCC did try a hybrid general meeting, would you be willing to attend?

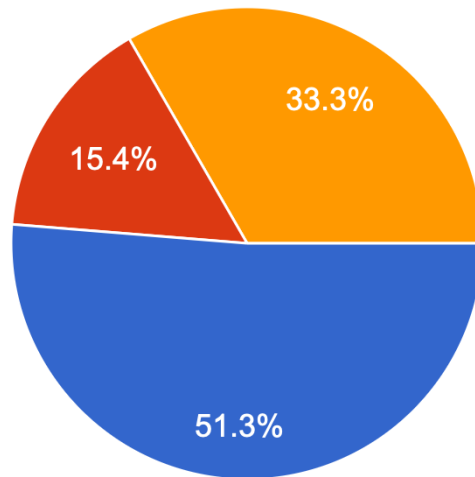

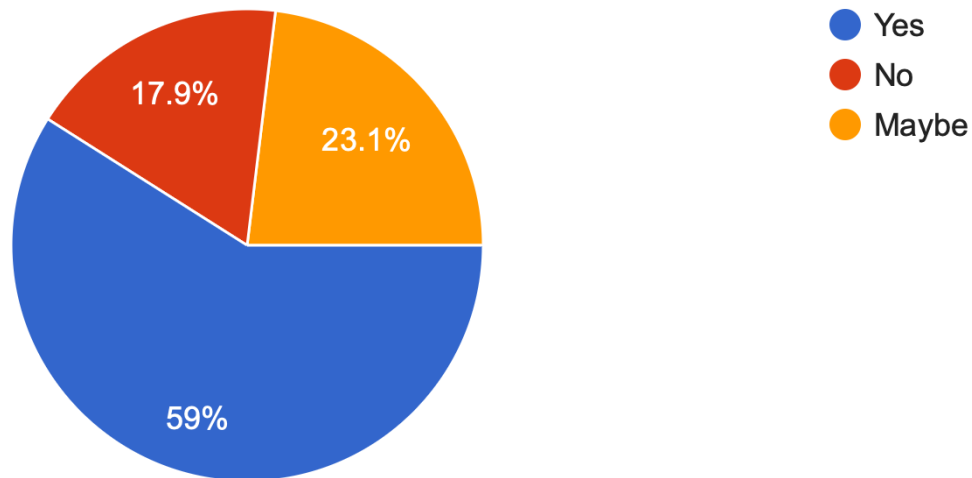
