Discussion on exhibition (1 of 2)

FC Center for Creativity (old Carnegie library) Weekly (Wed-Sun) costs range from \$100 (smallest gallery) to \$675 (all 3 galleries on a First Friday week) Presumably admission would have to be free (still not sure)

Original intent was possibly to try for as early as December, but this is unlikely for a number of reasons Would visitors be able to buy pictures? Intent is yes, as many renters are artists who are trying to sell their work. City will no longer assist with sales. Temporary sales tax license or leverage existing ones? May need to lean on experience of members who have sold photos. Might need someone on site.

Discussion on exhibition (2 of 2)

Perhaps there should be another survey on these questions:

Opinions on whether it should be a contest or juried? (mine is "no")
Organize by photographer or theme?
How many works should members be allowed to show? (my thinking maybe up to 5? Not sure)
Not sure about photo sizes or framing requirements
How long to exhibit? (1 week or 2 weeks?) Probably can't do this annually
Has anyone gone to the Center for Creativity since it reopened?

Exhibition survey results

August survey was on whether to do an exhibition

- Do you like this idea: 18 responses
 8 strongly support, 3 somewhat support, 5 neutral
- Would you contribute: 16 responses (11 yes, 1 maybe)
- Would cost to print be an issue? 16 responses, 10 no
- Willing to help set up? 16 responses (8 yes, 4 maybe)
- Would you go and see it? 16 responses (14 yes)
- Survey suggests we are lacking in experience in some areas for putting on an exhibition (organization, publicity)
